Visitor information

As a visitor you have a responsibility to care for your own and others health and safety. Please report any concerns to one or more of the above people as soon as possible.

Safeguarding and the protection of any of our staff or volunteers or visitors is a priority for Norwich FarmShare.

You should not be working unsupervised with children unless you have obtained prior permission from the farm manager and have undertaken an enhanced DBS check. All adults should follow the safeguarding procedures and if you are not comfortable with any working environment or any behavior of a Norwich FarmShare employee, a visitor or a volunteer please speak to one of the safeguarding team.

Visitor procedures

- Park your car in an appropriate space on the NFS field, not on adjacent properties
- Introduce yourself to one of the NFS employees after reading the site risk assessment (first visit only) and safeguarding procedures (first visit only)
- Always ask subjects for permission before taking photos especially where children are included
